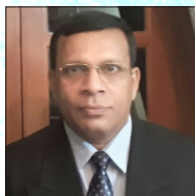
About the Association of College Directors of Physical Education, Goa (ACDOPEG)

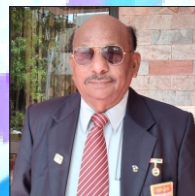

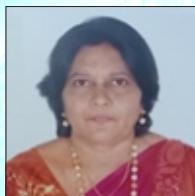

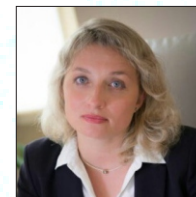
